UROPODINA (ACARI: MESOSTIGMATA) OF NATIONAL PARKS IN POLAND IN COMPARISON WITH OTHER AREAS

Summary

The paper rises some questions regarding the necessity of changes in the traditional faunistics. The obtained results prove that national parks play a substantial role in preserving the biological diversity of soil fauna. National parks occupy a small part of the coun-

try, however, they protect on their area nearly 70% of uropodid mites recorded in Poland. Since the rate of examination of individual parks is insufficient, this percentage is probably higher.
