SPECIFIC FEATURES OF THE CITIES CLIMATE IN THE ASPECT OF HUMAN HEALTH

Summary

Urban areas constitute a substantial share of geographical area and are characterised by a high expansion dynamics, which is manifested not only by changes in landscape scenery but also in health and life conditions of the inhabitants. The cities are marked with anthropogenic active areas which greatly modify the course of particular weather elements. The article presents the impact of the city on the spectrum of solar radiation, cloud cover, visibility, humidity, precipitation, wind direction and speed, air temperature (urban neat island) and air pollution.
